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- 3 The Company mainly operates in the business of manufacturing of Engines wherein two customer based reportable segments have been identified namely Business to Business ("B2B") and Business to Customer ("B2C"). However, as per para 4 of Ind AS 108 "Operating Segments", the Company is required to disclose segment information only in the Consolidated Financial Results. Accordingly, disclosure of this information has been included under Consolidated Financial Results for the quarter and half year ended 30th September 2025.
- 4 The above statement has been prepared in accordance with The Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under section 133 of The Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable.
- 5 The Board of Directors of the Company in its meeting held on 6th August 2025, had given its consent for further investment in 'Series A-1 Optionally Convertible Redeemable Non-Cumulative Preference Shares, (the "Series A-1 Preferred Stock OCRNPS") upto US\$ 2,000,000 (upto Rs. 18 Crores) (i.e. upto 200,000 shares of Preferred Stock at a purchase price of US\$ 10 per share) of Kirloskar Americas Corporation (hereinafter referred as 'KAC'), USA, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company. During the quarter ended 30th September 2025, the Company has invested US\$ 2,000,000 amounting to approximately ₹ 17.76 Crores in Series A-1 Preferred Stock- OCRNPS, as per payment terms covered in the Letter of Offer issued by KAC to the Company
- 6 Exceptional items reported during the year ended 31st March 2025 represents gain on sale of aircraft amounting to ₹ 20.90 Crores
- 7 The Company consistently recognizes provision for any significantly delayed receivables, for accounting of expected credit losses. With respect to the provision made for the receivables against sales of Gensets to a specific customer in prior years, the (income) or expense in the Statement of Profit and Loss for the quarter ended 30th September 2025 was Nil (₹ {41.47} Crores for FY 2024-2025; Nil during the quarter ended 30th June 2025 and ₹ (17.44) Crores during the quarter ended 30th September 2024].
- The Nomination and Remuneration Committee of the Board of Directors of the Company in its meeting held on 6th August 2025 has approved the grant of 21,129 employee stock options to an eligible employee of the Company in terms of 'Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited Employee Stock Option Plan 2019 ("KOEL ESOP 2019") and the special resolutions passed by the Members of the Company at the Annual General Meeting held on 9th August 2019 and 12th August 2021.
- 9 During the quarter ended 30th September 2025, the Company has allotted 40,448 fully paid-up equity shares of ₹ 2/- each to the option grantees upon exercise of Employee Stock Options pursuant to 'Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited Employee Stock Option Plan 2019' ('KOEL ESOP 2019'). Consequent to aforesaid allotment, the paid-up equity shares capital of the Company has increased from 14,52,54,687 fully paid-up equity shares of ₹ 2/- each to 14,52,95,135 fully paid-up equity shares of ₹ 2/- each.
- Subsequent to the quarter ended 30th September 2025, the Board of Directors of the Company in its meeting held on 10th October 2025 approved the transfer of the Company's Business to Customer ("82C") business segment i.e. Water Management Solutions ("WMS") Domestic & Exports Business by way of slump sale as a going concern to its wholly owned subsidiary, La-Gaijar Machineries Private Limited ("LGM").

The consideration is in the form of issuance and allotment of 10,65,150 equity shares of LGM having face value of ₹ 10/- each to the Company, on a private placement basis, on terms as set out in the Business Transfer Agreement executed on 10th October 2025. The aforesaid B2C business segment of the Company is transferred to LGM with effect from 11th October 2025.

- 11 The figures for the previous periods have been regrouped wherever required to make them comparable with those of the current periods. The impact of such regroupings is not material to the financial results.
- 12 The above standalone financial results for the quarter and half year ended 30th September 2025 are reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Company in their respective meetings held on 11th November 2025 and are subjected to a "Limited Review" by the Statutory Auditors of the Company.

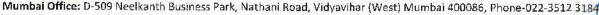

The Board of Directors Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited

- We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited standalone financial results
 of Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited ("the Company") for the quarter and half year ended
 September 30, 2025 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the
 requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure
 Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('the Listing Regulations').
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters and applying analytical and other review procedures. 1 The Group ("the Parent Company and its subsidiaries") operates in the business of manufacturing of Engines and Pumps wherein two customer based reportable segments have been identified namely - Business to Business ("B2B") and Business to Customer ("B2C") However, as per para 4 of Ind AS 108 "Operating Segments", Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited ("the Parent Company") is required to disclose segment information only in the Consolidated Financial Results. At consolidated level, the Group has identified three operating reportable segments namely B2B, B2C and Financial Services. The identification of operating segments is consistent with performance assessment and resource allocation by the management.

During the quarter ended 30th June 2025, the Group reorganized Farm Mechanization Solutions, one of its business components, from B2C to B2B business segment with effect from 1st April 2025, in an effort to improve synergy, since its products are more complementary to the Agri product line of the Industrial business unit (82B segment). The previous period figures have been presented after incorporating necessary reclassification adjustments pursuant to the reorganisation within the reportable segments

 - D) Unallocable Unallocable comprises of assets, liabilities, revenue and expenses which are not directly related with any of the operating segments.
- 5 The above statement has been prepared in accordance with The Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under section 133 of The Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable.
- 6 The Board of Directors of the Parent Company in its meeting held on 6th August 2025, had given its consent for further investment in 'Series A-1 Optionally Convertible Redeemable Non-Cumulative Preference Shares, (the "Series A-1 Preferred Stock OCRNPS") upto US\$ 2,000,000 (upto Rs. 18 Crores) (i.e. upto 200,000 shares of Preferred Stock at a purchase price of US\$ 10 per share) of Kirloskar Americas Corporation (hereinafter referred as 'KAC'), USA, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Parent Company. During the quarter ended 30th September 2025, the Parent Company has invested US\$ 2,000,000 amounting to approximately ₹ 17.76 Crores in Series A-1 Preferred Stock- OCRNPS, as per payment terms covered in the Letter of Offer issued by KAC to the Parent Company.
- 7 The Group consistently recognizes provision for any significantly delayed receivables, for accounting of expected credit losses. With respect to the provision made for the receivables against sales of Gensets to a specific customer in prior years, the (income) or expense in the Statement of Profit and Loss for the quarter ended 30th September 2025 was Nil (₹ (41,47) Crores for FY 2024-2025; Nil during the quarter ended 30th June 2025 and ₹ (17,44) Crores during the quarter ended 30th September 2024).
- 8 Exceptional Items reported :
 - i) during the year ended 31st March 2025 represents gain on sale of aircraft amounting to ₹ 20.90 Crores and
 - ii) represents reversal of earlier year's recorded provision by Arka Fincap Limited (AFL) amounting to ₹ 7.42 Crores during the quarter ended 30th June 2024 and additional ₹ 7.87 Crores during the quarter ended 30th September 2024. Accordingly, the total provision of ₹ 15.29 Crores was reversed during the year ended 31st March 2025.
- 9 Arka Fincap Limited has assessed certain loans originated during the half year ended 30th September 2025 under the business model of "Hold & Sell". Accordingly, the fair value gain on such loans has been disclosed as "Fair value changes on loans classified under "Hold & Sell" business model" under Other Comprehensive Income.

10 Note on Discontinued operations

During the previous quarter ended 30th June 2025, La-Gaijar Machineries Private Limited ("LGM") transferred its 'Cables, Wires & Pipes business' ("undertaking") by way of Slump Sale on a going concern basis at an aggregate consideration of ₹ 10,70 Crores subject to closing adjustments by executing Business Transfer Agreement (BTA) on 30th June 2025 (Closing date) between LGM and the Buyer i.e Vira Logistics and accordingly the 'Cables, Wires & Pipes business' of LGM was transferred to the Buyer w.e.f. Closing date.

Independent Auditor's Review Report on Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results of Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited for the Quarter and Half year ended September 30, 2025 pursuant to the Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.

The Board of Directors Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited consolidated financial results of Kirloskar Oil Engines Limited ("the Parent") and its subsidiaries (the Parent and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group"), for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2025 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('the Listing Regulations').
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's Management and approved by the Parent's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Parent's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under Section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33 (8) of the Listing Regulations, as amended, to the extent applicable.

4. The Statement includes the results of following subsidiaries and step-down subsidiaries:

- b. Arka Investment Advisory Services Private Limited ("AIASPL") (Wholly owned Subsidiary of AFHPL)
- c. Engines LPG, LLC dba Wildcat Power Gen (Subsidiary of KAC)
- 5. Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditors referred to in paragraph 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Ind AS 34 and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

6. Other Matters:

(i) We did not review the unaudited consolidated financial results of a subsidiary and unaudited standalone financial results of two other subsidiaries, included in the Statement, whose financial results, before consolidation adjustments, reflect total assets of Rs. 7,248.01 Crores as at September 30, 2025, total income of Rs. 365.95 Crores and Rs. 717.18 Crores, total net profit of Rs. 29.78 Crores and Rs. 49.22 Crores and total comprehensive income of Rs. 48.10 Crores and Rs. 84.58 crores for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2025 respectively and cash inflow of Rs. 114.50 Crores for the half year ended September 30, 2025 as considered in the unaudited consolidated financial results. These financial results have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

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(ii) The unaudited consolidated financial results include the unaudited consolidated financial results of a subsidiary, which have not been subjected to review and have been furnished to us by the management. These financial results, before consolidation adjustments, reflect total assets of Rs. 88.95 Crores as at September 30, 2025, total income of Rs. 16.64 Crores and Rs. 23.41 Crores, total net profit / (loss) of (Rs. 6.90 Crores) and (Rs. 11.60 Crores) and total comprehensive income / (loss) of (Rs. 7.23 Crores) and (Rs. 12.00 Crores) for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2025 respectively and cash inflow of Rs. 13.48 Crores for the half year ended September 30, 2025 as considered in the unaudited consolidated financial results. According to the information and explanations given to us, these financial results are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion on the statement is not modified in respect of above matters.
